Kandahar historical review



In 2001 Ethel Robson completed a history of Kandahar begun by her husband Gordon, who founded the Club in 1954. Please separate waste and recyclables:

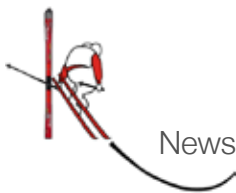
